

Clubber Registration Instructions

If you need assistance filling out this form, please feel free to call Laura Klassen at (507) 831-1523.

- Click on the PDF link. Print the document.
- Please fill out all blanks to the best of your knowledge. The more information we have, the better we can serve you. We will not share your information with anyone but your child's AWANA leader and the church.
- If parents live in separate houses, please provide address where you would like your child to receive mail.
- Cubbies (Ages 3-5) and Sparks (Grades K-2) age children **MUST** be picked up by a parent or someone listed on the registration form. Sorry, we cannot allow siblings to pick up young children. If you need to add someone allowed to pick up your child later, please notify a secretary.
- If either parent has a cell phone, please provide that number. The cell phone number is the first number we call if there is an emergency with your child. We will use your emergency contact **ONLY** if we cannot reach the parent(s).

Please list all children in your family that you are registering for Awana. Birthdate and Grade are used to determine which club (Cubbies, Sparks, T&T, or Youth Group) your child will attend. If you would like to register more children than the form has room to list, please include Name, Birthdate, Gender, & Grade on a separate form **OR** include that information in the email when you send your registration.

If your child is age 3, 4, or 5 and not in Kindergarten, please register for CUBBIES.

If your child is in grades K, 1 or 2, please register for SPARKS.

If your child is in grades 3, 4, or 5, please register for T&T.

If your child is in grade 6, he or she may choose to attend Awana at BARC in T&T **OR** he or she may choose to attend Middle School Youth Group at the Center (965 3rd Ave. Windom, MN). We ask that whichever group your child chooses, he or she continue attending for one month before making any decision to change. If your child attends BARC, he or she will be asked to work in a T&T book. If your child attends the Center, he or she will be given the option to work in a Trek book. Only children who participate in T&T will be able to participate in AwanaGames in March.

- Because we serve candy and treats at Awana, we ask that you include food *allergies* on the form. Medication allergies will only be used if we cannot reach you or your emergency contact in case of emergency.
- If you are interested in helping with Awana, please let us know. We complete a background check on all adults working with the children with Awana. We also ask anyone interested in helping to talk to the Awana commanders, a WEFC pastor, a WEFC elder or Awana director about your religious beliefs. WEFC Awana is a ministry of Windom Evangelical Free Church and all leaders must sign a statement of faith.
